

## Step-by-Step Setup

1. **Place the Rack**
  - Set the wire rack on a flat, heat-safe surface away from flammable items.
2. **Insert the Water Pan**
  - Put one aluminum pan into the rack.
  - Fill halfway with **hot water** — this creates gentle, moist heat.
3. **Add the Fuel**
  - Place **two chafing fuel cans inside the rack**, centered under the water pan.
  - Light each can carefully using a long lighter.
4. **Add the Food Pan**
  - Set the second aluminum pan (filled with food) directly on top of the water pan.
  - Ensure it sits flat and stable.
5. **Cover and Maintain**
  - Use a lid or foil to retain heat and moisture.
  - Stir food occasionally and check the water level every 30 minutes.
6. **After Use**
  - Extinguish flames by covering fuel cans with their lids.
  - Let everything cool before handling or packing.

### Safety Tips

- Never leave the setup unattended.
- Keep children and pets away from open flames.
- Do not move the rack while fuel is lit.
- Dispose of used fuel cans only after they are completely cool.
